Please include the word keynote in your submission if you are planning on applying for a keynote presentation. The length of each workshop will be about 90 minutes. Video conferencing over the Internet is also available. Your ideas are critical in making the conference and Emille enriching, important and substantial. We look forward to reviewing everyone's entry.
